

Take A Stroll Down Memory Lane

AT THE 10TH ANNUAL FESTIVAL OF TREES

Which you could go back in time? Ann Norton Sculpture Gardens (ANSO) is preparing to transport visitors through the decades for its milestone 10th Annual Festival of Trees. Presented by leading private aviation firm Sentient Jet, the annual holiday tradition takes off on December 2nd and lands on December 14th. Visitors will unwind the magic of design with more than 25 professionally decorated trees that have been sponsored by area patrons and businesses. Interior designers, artists and florists volunteer their services and work together to interpret an annual theme, cleverly decorate the trees and carry the storyline through vignettes staged around each tree.

This year's theme, Celebrating Design through the Decades, will illuminate the importance of design throughout history and the great context it brings for the culture and temperament of the times. To expand on the theme of this year's Festival of Trees, Palm Beach-based Hidden Lutz Gallery is curating an exhibition in the ANSO Gallery entitled Eye on Photography: A Survey of Contemporary Themes. The Hidden Lutz Gallery will present a collection of photos that focuses on artfully captured moments of design through the ages. Opening on November 9th and running through December 28th, the iconic imagery complements the Festival of Trees theme, and the eccentric, yet chic styles of the decorated trees.

"We are delighted to kick off our season with this incredible exhibition with Hidden Lutz Gallery," said Frances Fisher, President of the ANSO Board of Trustees. "It represents an intended departure from the typical exhibitions the Gardens has hosted in the past and we are grateful to Sally Soter and the Gardens' art committee for their work in securing it. Not only does it tie into our Festival of Trees theme this year, it also raises the bar for the exhibitions we are planning for the season ahead. As an acclaimed artist in her own right, Ann Norton would have been so pleased to know that her home was a venue for artists, art lovers and collectors to gather. It is an honor to brighten the spotlight on that piece of her history this season."

Each room of the Ann Norton Sculpture Gardens Gallery will feature different decades of photography. Artists include **Berenice Abbott, Clive Aronowitz, John Dugdale, Elliott Erwitt, Robert Fisher, Massimo Listi, Michael Nassos, Robin Pitzer and Bill Wit.** Hidden Lutz has put together the collection with the Festival of Trees in mind and with the intention to amaze visitors.

"We are thrilled to be working with the Ann Norton Sculpture Gardens to curate this high-caliber exhibition in their beautiful venue," said Jodi Lutz. "Eye on Photography represents a fresh approach to the Gardens' exhibition schedule and is reflective of the types of future exhibitions they plan to host. We hope this is the beginning of a long-term partnership in which visitors will experience a new take on the Gardens when they visit this exhibit as part of the Festival of Trees theme this year."

According to Lutz, when visitors walk into the first room of the exhibit,

they will see modern fashion, design and style of the 1960s and 70s. The next room will have a timeless, sophisticated feel where you won't be able to tell if the pictures were taken in the 1800s or yesterday. The last room will feature American architecture and humanism of the 1940s and 50s.

"Each room will have its own feel," said Lutz. "But they will all tie together to make one cohesive story of design. I think when it's all put together, people will walk in and think, 'wow!'"

Opening night reception to Eye on Photography: A Survey of Contemporary Themes on November 9th, from 6pm to 8pm, is free for members and \$15 for non-member adults. Regular Gallery visitation is Wednesday through Sunday, 10am to 4pm, and is free for members, \$10 for non-member adults, \$8 for seniors (age 65 and older), \$7 for students and children under five are free. The holiday festival kicks off with its elegant Gala Evening in the Gardens on Friday, December 2nd from 7pm to 10pm. The Children's Gala, taking place on Sunday, December 11th from 5pm to 7pm, includes a night of mini-merriment with child-friendly refreshments and tasty treats. The Community Days take place Saturday, December 3rd through Saturday, December 10th and then again on Monday, December 12nd through Wednesday, December 14th from 6pm to 8:30pm. Visitors will delight in the magic of the trees each evening while exploring the tropical winter wonderland. Delicious fare from **EnKa** restaurant will be available for purchase, and an array of entertainment will surround the artistically decorated trees.

This year's 10th Annual Festival of Trees' Honorary Chair is **K.C. Pickett**, Co-Chairs are **Sarah Benitz** and **Regan Rupp** and the Design Chair is **Jennifer Gurgues**.

During Festival of Trees, the Gardens offers extended hours and dates with special ticket prices. organization established in 1977 by the prominent sculptor Ann Weaver Norton (1905-1982). Listed on the National Register of Historic Places, it is located at 2051 South Pflagler Drive. The 2-acre sanctuary is comprised of rare palm and sculpture gardens, Ann Norton's historic home, exhibition galleries and Norton's own Wyeth-designed artist studio. Open to the public Wednesday through Sunday from 10am to 4pm and closed on major holidays, the Gardens are also available for private events.
