Artist **Sharon Koskoff** will present the keynote address June 19 at the third annual Art Deco Festival in Perpignan, France.

Koskoff, founding president of the **Art Deco Society of the Palm Beaches**, will discuss how the Palm Beach area preserves its Art Deco architectural gems. She said she will focus on the Lake Avenue Theater built in 1939, now home of the county's Cultural Council; the Armory Art Center, which also was built in 1939, and the Lake Worth Playhouse, which was constructed in 1924.

She also will sign her book, *Art Deco of the Palm Beaches*.

The festival in southern France runs from June 15 to 21.
