4. ROCK ON

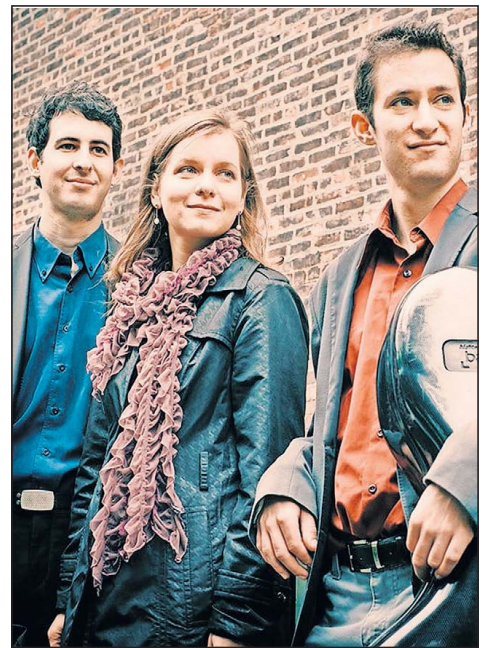
Candlebox, Culture Room
